Keith almost takes off his Timber, but the battery is not up to snuff and the take off is aborted. But, there is enough juice left to taxi back to shore.



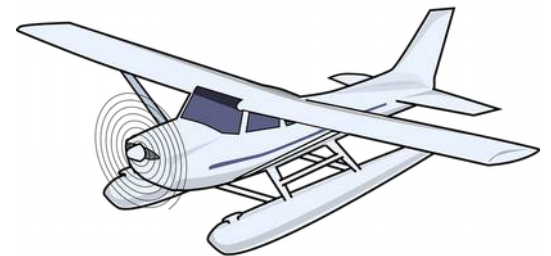

June's Club Meeting



Gerhard Roos shows a fully controllable 3-axis stabilizer by HobbyEagle (\$22) that he recommends using on initial flights of a new airplane, it will save the plane if it gets out of control. The stabilizer is inserted between the Rx and the servos and can be controlled via an extra Rx channel while in flight.

Tony Naef shows his Thunder Tiger Titan X50 Nitro powered helicopter and mentions the importance of having a header fuel tank which keeps air bubbles out of the fuel flow. Such bubbles could cause a brief but dangerous loss of power and perhaps the crash and destruction of an expensive helicopter.

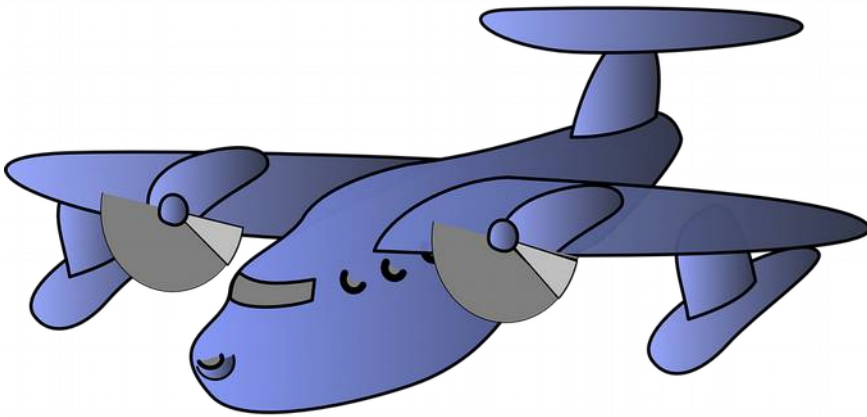


Tony shows an updated version of Wayne Giles' popular LiPo ESR battery tester. It measures the internal Equivalent Series Resistance (ESR) of battery packs on a per cell or total basis and determines the actual C rating of the battery. Such information is useful for evaluating battery packs in critical applications where power failure can wreck an expensive helicopter or plane. More info at
