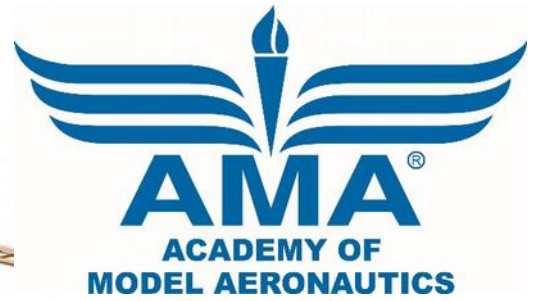


# January 2019 Newsletter
